The Town of Ledgeview's 2022 Strategic Plan highlights the continued growth in Ledgeview and the need to evaluate residential services offered by the Public Works Department.






Q1_1 - Importance - Management of Stormwater/Drainage



Q2_1 - Satisfaction - Management of Stormwater/Drainage




Q1_2 - Importance - Roadside Ditch Mowing




Q1_3 - Importance - Sewer Service











Q1_5 - Importance - Street Lighting








Q1_6 - Importance - Street Sweeping




Q2_6 - Satisfaction - Street Sweeping




Q1_7 - Importance - Street Tree Maintenance







Q1_10 - Importance - Weekly Garbage & Recyling Collection




Q2_10 - Satisfaction - Weekly Garbage & Recyling Collection











Q9 - Which of the following do you use for information regarding the Town of Ledgeview? (Check all that apply.)





The designated bike lanes that Ledgeview has posted are very dangerous in many areas. This is very very misleading and disappointing to bikers!!!!
Always unhappy every year with how the larger snowplows leave excessive amounts of snow in front of only my house (culdesac) every year, and totally bury my driveway and mailbox when there is other areas that the snow could also be moved to to reduce the impact of always pushing the snow of the entire circle every snowfall to one 25' area on the circle. I appreciate the smaller truck trying to help, but they are not always able to. This snow distribution has nothing to do with where the mailbox or driveway are located - as when the big plow comes in they clear the entire circle and then push it all to one spot in front of my house, and then leaves the pile extend five or more feet in the street
I had a bad experience on the bike route that uses Dutchman Road. Nice new pavement, but the road is used by large trucks and is a major connecting road to I43. An over-sized

vehicle hauling part of a mobile home passed me at normal speed with oncoming traffic. The force of the gust combined with the close proximity to the shoulder where I was riding put me off the road. Also, Stagecoach Road was in such poor condition I had to ride left of center. The worst part was trying to ride on R. The bike route puts riders on R where it goes from 2 lanes to 1, with rumble strips on the shoulder, and a left turn from R to Shadow. R is very busy with all types of vehicles, so putting a cyclist in a lane of traffic to turn left is not safe for cyclists or motorists. We didn't make it that far, as while trying to ride on the rumbled-stripped shoulder as vehicles passed us, the alarms our Garmin computers starting blaring because it assumed we had crashed (due to the bumps). I had 30 seconds to cancel calls to contacts and 911. Its clear that by having rumble strips on the shoulder that this is an area where vehicles drift onto the shoulder. I've planned bike routes and led rides over the years, and the one thing I've learned is to plan routes that reduce the risk to cyclists and motorists. This is not a complaint, but a concern for having the Ledgeview name on the risky route. I rerouted it with no need to be on or Dutchman or R, and would be happy to share this with you. Katy 608-220-2997. Again, this is not a complaint.

Bicycle route road signs are not useful. Bike lane paint on the roads are not useful, cars do not respect bicyclist safety or space. Roads that are labeled bike routes are not smooth or clean for bikers. Thank you for trying.

We feel the cost of road maintenance should be spread across the entire town, or the subdivision, if it is in an "off the beaten trail" rather than individual house. 2) Some of the questions, such as the one on sidewalks, were answered with a "neither satisified nor dissatisfied" because, without room for comment, a "dissatisfied" answer could be taken as "they want more" or "we feel there is already too many" (such as having one on each side of Bower Creek). If we answered it with "satisfied" it could be taken as "they are happy with the amount we have put in and would like to continue to see us install more" vs "we feel there are more than enough and we don't want anymore...especially in front of our house." A better way to have phrased the question may have been "Do you believe we need more" identifies of the community. Therefore, the community should have to pay for any needed repairs to them, not the homeowner (maybe this is already being done in which case we thank you for realizing that individual homeowners should not be responsible for covering the cost for items that benefit the community). 3) In regards to garbage can size and pickup. Not all families generate a lot of garbage/recycle on a weekly basis but we understand that there are families that do (we typically set ours out every 3-5 weeks). Rather than forcing all residents to take larger, bulkier, cans that can be difficult to maneuver and store (especially for elderly), how about going with smaller cans and allowing the families that generate a lot of waste the option of having two cans.

Landscaping requirements of new construction should be upgraded to enhance the appearance of new construction. This is especially true of new apartments. Suggest using Hobart as a guideline. Bike lanes / wider paved shoulders need to be added to streets such as Dickinson, Heritage, and Creamery Road. A new access road needs to be built for the apartments off of Cottonwood Road.
