Role Requirements

Knowledge of vehicle/trailer operation with a good driving record, general knowledge of building, grounds and equipment maintenance and the ability to operate hand/power tools, zero-turn lawnmower, line trimmer and possesses the ability to perform manual labor for extended periods of time in all types of weather conditions is desired.

Hours

Public Works Seasonal Members are hourly employees scheduled for 40 hours per week (May through September). Regular work hours are Monday – Thursday, 6:30AM – 3:30PM and Friday, 6:30AM -10:30AM. Ledgeview values our employees’ family time and therefore will be flexible when it comes to planned family vacations.

Wage and Benefits

We want to make this role worthwhile for you. Starting rate for this position is \$12.00/hr - \$15.00/hr.
