

## Bike Loops



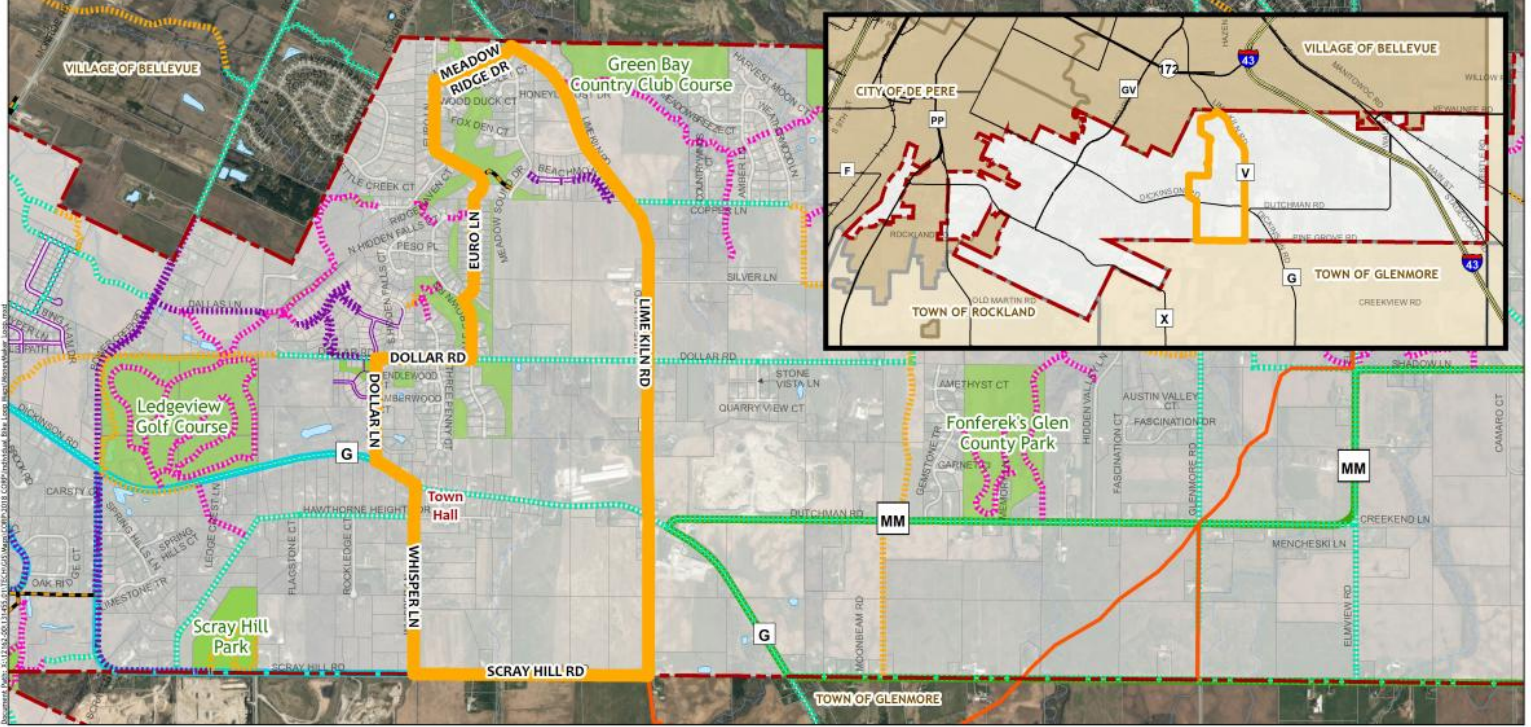
A dominant environmental feature of the Town is the Niagara escarpment, a limestone ridge that runs roughly north and south through the middle of the Town. Locally this feature is known as the “Ledge.” With mostly low-trafficked roads, scenic beauty, and topography, Ledgeview was the perfect place to create bike routes known as “loops” to provide an avenue for residents and visitors to explore and enjoy the nature-scape of Ledgeview by bicycle. Hence the Ledgeview Bike Loops Program. Get out and bike!

Bicycling is very popular in the Town due to its mostly low-trafficked roads, scenic beauty, and topography. Through a survey, residents have expressed a strong desire to maintain and improve the bike-ability of the Town. Hence, Ledgeview Bike Loops were created.

In May of 2018, with the help of WE BIKE, etc., LLC, the [Ledgeview Loops Study](#) revealed residents desire for bicycling opportunities in order to enjoy and explore the nature-scape Ledgeview has to offer.

Four loops were mapped based on engineering, education, and enforcement. All loops have appropriate signage and markers along their route.

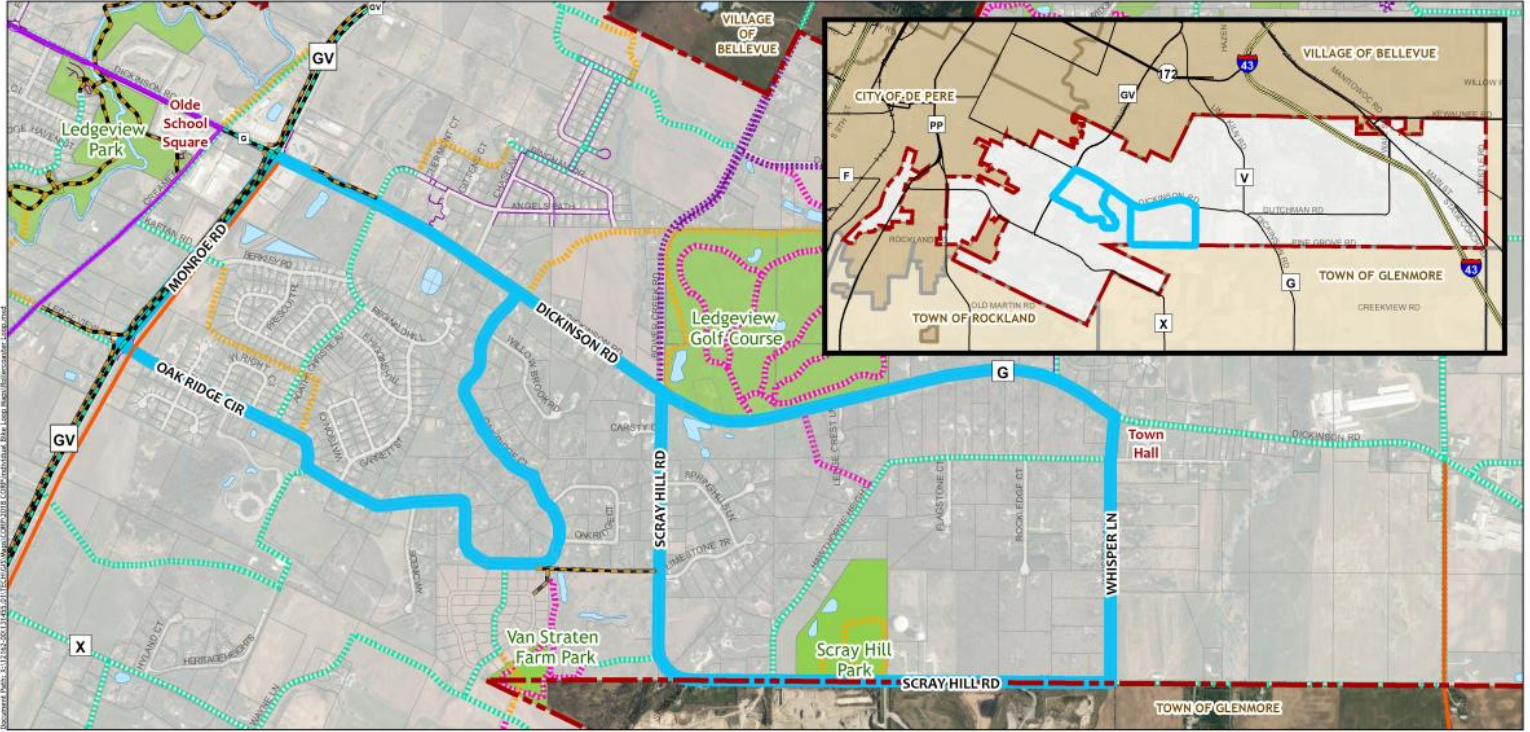

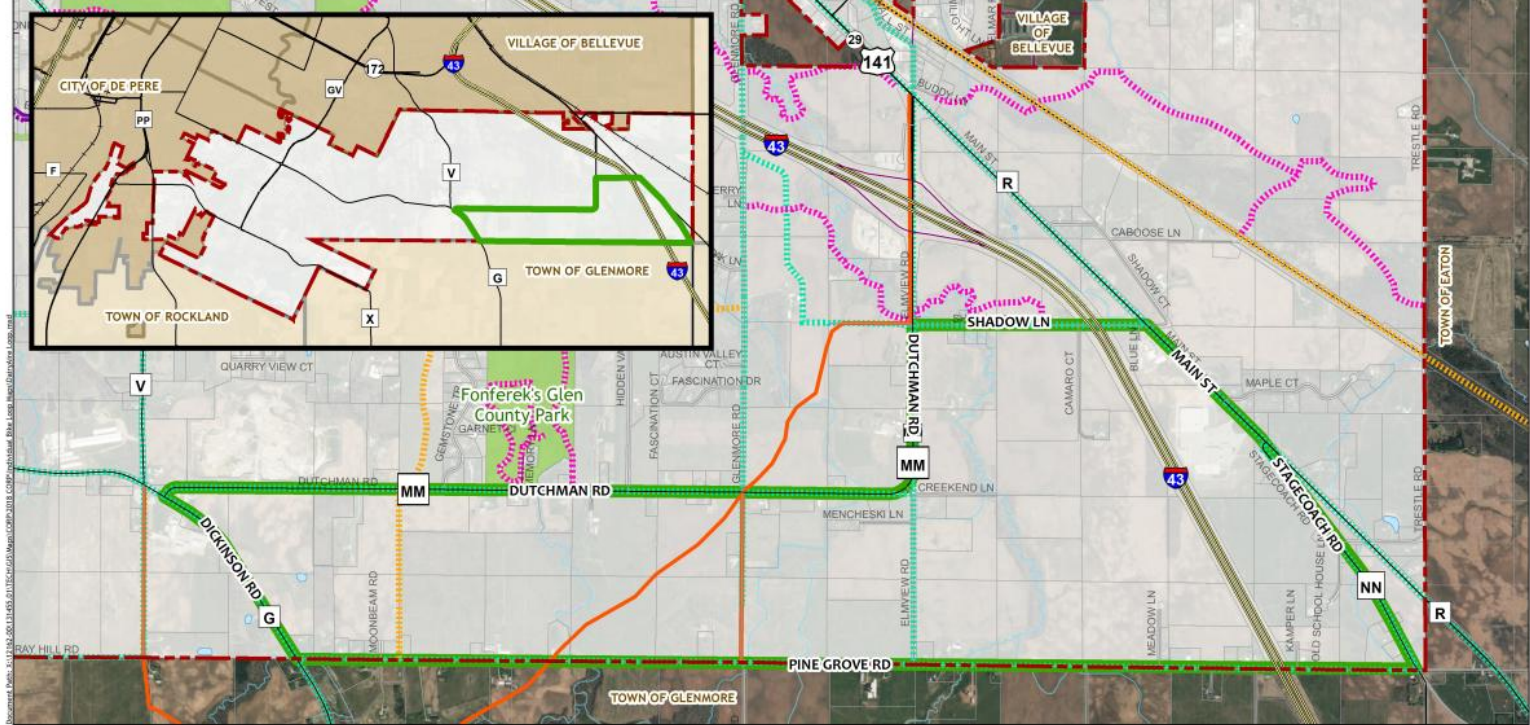

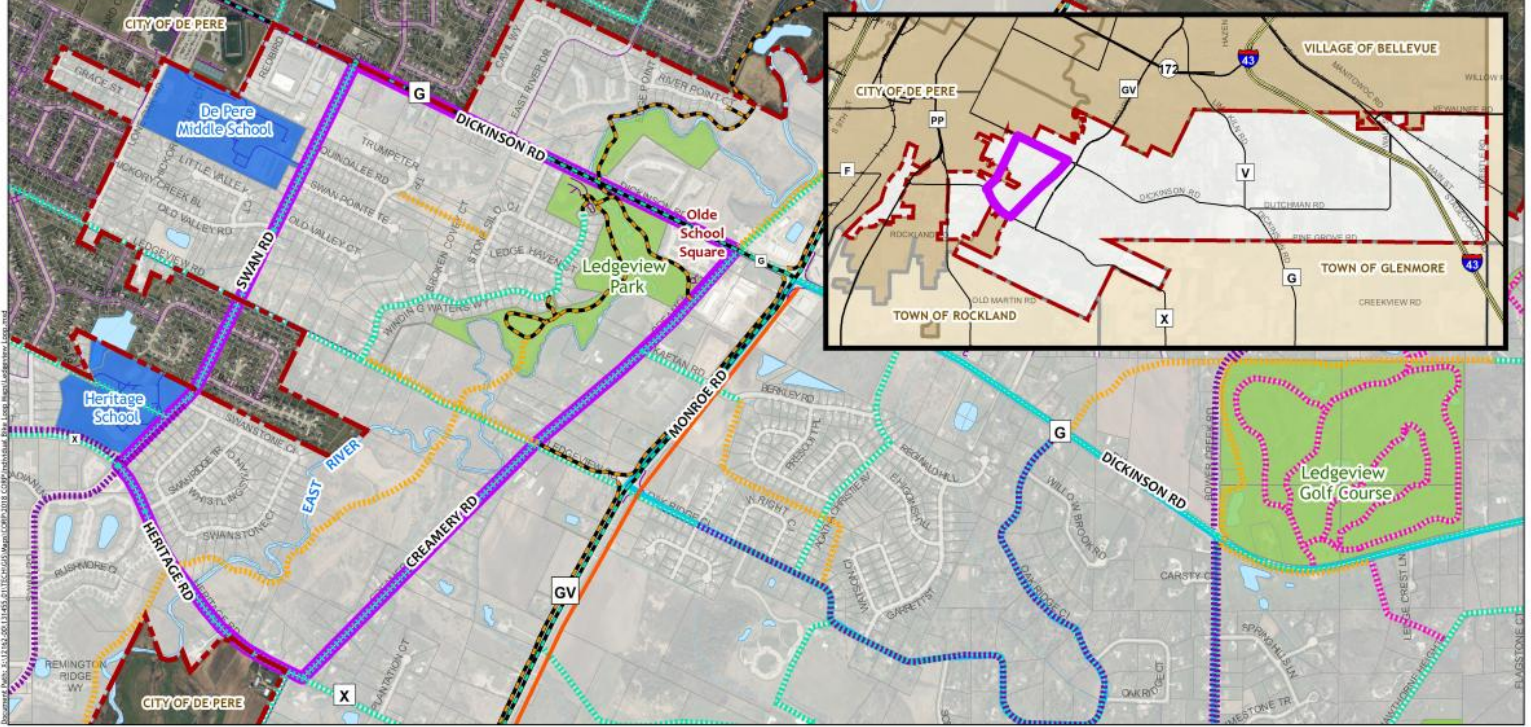
