Preserved and enhanced natural areas—ravines, streams, a regional bike path, meandering trails, and a trailhead park—help define a natural character to this well designed mixture of light industrial uses, corporate/support, large-format retail site with outlots, and pedestrian-scaled mixed use areas.



Neighborhood Center Districts

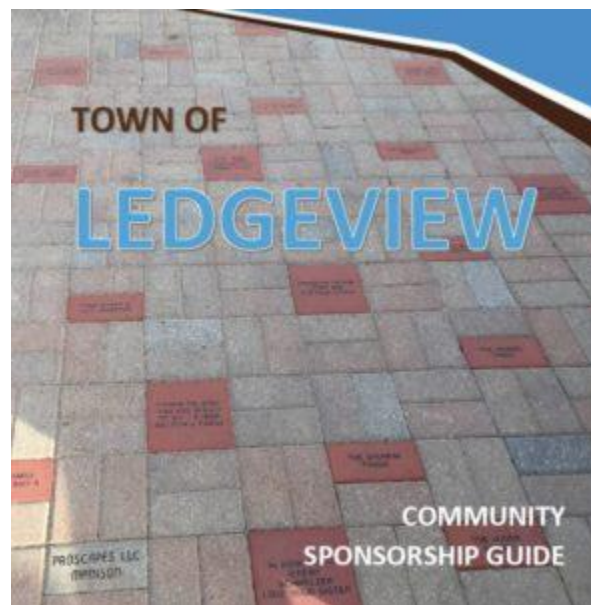


The intent of the Neighborhood Center Districts (NCD) is to create a renewed mix of pedestrian-scale commercial, residential, recreational, and institutional uses to meet the daily needs of residents. The primary NCDs include the town center at CTH GV/Dickinson Road in addition to Dickinson Road/Creamery Road, CTH GV/Heritage Road, and the PDDBP Business Park near I-43/CTH MM. The
